

Training Course and Manual on Constitutional Analysis



The objective of developing a short training course, the first of its kind in Sudan, is to alert participants about the concept of developing criteria and checklists to guide the development of the constitution. In addition, it is intended to promote their capacities to analyze and assess the constitution in reference to certain principles and criteria.

The six-day course was developed by four experts and given to a total of 35 participants from 13 universities in different states, as well as ministries and media in Khartoum.

The purpose of targeting universities' centres for peace, or community development or faculties of law, education and political science is to create a body of trainers/experts at those universities for future training in each state.

An intensive Training of Trainers (TOT) was also given to 16 selected participants from the states, to enrich their training capacities.

A third cycle of the same training course was given to a different target group, of political parties, civil society organisations, parliamentarians and universities in Khartoum state.

A total of 53 males and 49 females attended the courses.
